TRUE OR FALSE QUESTIONS

 1.	We call the object of a human act the true or apparent good that is chosen.
 2.	The purpose for which a human person performs an act we call the intention, or end.
 3.	Circumstances, including the consequences, of a human act cannot make an otherwise good human act evil.
 4.	We believe that there are times when a good end, or intention, will justify evil means to attain it, as in the case of a just war.
 5.	We believe, in certain circumstances, in the choosing the lesser of two evils.
 6.	We know of no good reason why God permits evil, but must accept blindly by faith that He does permit it.
7	Ironically, evil an itself may bring about greater good, as in the crucifizion of Christ

GOD IS PERFECTLY GOOD IN HOLINESS AND LOVE, AND THE SOURCE AND END OF ALL THAT IS GOOD.

- The One God is perfectly holy separated from evil in His essence, substance, and nature
- God loves perfectly as a Communion of Divine Persons Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

GOODNESS OF CREATION — THE ORIGINAL CALL TO GOODNESS AND LOVE — HOLY COMMUNION

- Creation and its creatures glorify God's goodness by reflecting His glory:
 - "And God saw that the light was good."

- Genesis 1:4

- "And God saw that it was GOOD."
 - Genesis 1:10, 12, 18, 21, 25
- "And God saw everything that He had made, and behold, it was very good."

- Genesis 1:31

- But: "Then the Lord God said, 'It is not good that man should be alone."

- Genesis 2:18

- God made His rational, personal creatures (angels and men) as good to choose in freedom (obedience) to participate forever in this goodness (blessedness/happiness) by the gift of life (Father), the way of truth (Jesus), and the power of love (Holy Spirit) Two ways were presented to human persons the Good Way of Life and the Evil Way of Death
 - "And out of the ground the Lord God made to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food, the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil."

GOOD LIFE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

THE HOLY SACRIFICE OF THE MASS — EATING FROM THE TREE OF LIFE FOR THE GOOD LIFE RATHER THAN EATING FROM THE TREE OF KNOWLEDGE OF GOOD AND EVIL FOR DEATH

MASS UNFOLDS AS GOOD OVERCOMES EVIL

- The Sign of the Cross (The Tree of Life):
 - Incarnation for grace overcomes infestation from sin
 - Loving sacrifice and saving supper overcomes selfishness and greed
 - Trinitarian God Who is Love as an Eternal Holy Communion of Divine Persons overcomes the alienation of the world, the flesh, and the Devil
- "I Confess" Humility and honesty overcomes pride and dishonesty
- "Lord have mercy" The Mercy of God overcomes the envy of the Devil
- "Glory to God in the highest Glorifying God crushes vanity and narcissism
- Scripture, Gospel, Homily, Creed Truth vanquishes the lies of the world and the Devil
- Petitions Trust and dependence in God overcomes independence and idolatry
- Eucharistic Prayer, Holy Communion Worship in Spirit and Truth replaces idolatry and slavery to the Devil By the power of the Holy Spirit (Love), I give myself through, with, and in Jesus (Truth), to the Father (Perfect Goodness), so that the Father (Perfect Goodness), will give to others — through, with, and in me
 — His Son (Truth), in the power of the Holy Spirit (Love)
- Reflection after Holy Communion Contemplation overcomes ignorance and error
- "Go and announce of the Gospel of the Lord": Evangelization and Mission defeats Satan's Kingdom and establishes God's Kingdom and Family

HOW TO EXPERIENCE THE LIFE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT — BELIEVE, CELEBRATE, LIVE, PRAY

- Believe Renew your Baptismal Promises each morning for freedom from Satan and sin, and instead life in the Holy Spirit and grace. Then pray the "Hail, Holy Queen," who is Mother of all those who believe in God.
- Celebrate Freely cooperate with the Holy Spirit and Worship in Spirit and Truth:
 - If you are aware of grave or mortal sin(s) **Go to Confession** to restore a life of freedom in sanctifying grace and the Holy Spirit.
 - Attend Mass when required and receive communion in a state of grace This nourishes a life of holy freedom
 - Recite "The Anima Christi" reverently after Holy Mass before departing "to announce the Gospel of the Lord."
- Life Ask the Holy Spirit and your guardian angel to remind you:
 - To acknowledge Christ's Presence in the Eucharist at points during each day
 - To call upon Mary at points during each day
 - To call upon the Holy Spirit to increase your freedom for true love of God and of neighbor
 - In times when you are tempted to sin out of fear
 - In times when you are tempted to sin by "eating" forbidden fruit
- Prayer Examination of Conscience and sincere "Act of Contrition," "Our Father," "Hail Mary," and "Glory Be" before going to sleep
- Central Focus
 - Getting into and remaining in a state of grace by obeying God, which bears fruit by:
 - Giving clarity of vision— Purity of Heart
 - Putting love of God and neighbor into action

CLOSING REFLECTION

Saint Paul writes to the Romans: "[God] will repay everyone according to his works, eternal life to those who seek glory, honor, and immortality through perseverance in good works, but wrath and fury to those who selfishly disobey the truth and obey wickedness. Yes, affliction and distress will come upon everyone who does evil, Jew first and then Greek. But there will be glory, honor, and peace for everyone who does good, Jew first and then Greek. There is no partiality with God."

- Romans 2:6-11 Consider each good deed you have done today with the right intention and in the proper circumstances, that you believe would withstand the scrutiny of the Holy Spirit of Truth. Consider each wicked deed you have done today in selfish disobedience, considering the good (true or apparent), the intention, and the circumstances. Ask the Holy Spirit strengthen in your soul the gifts of knowledge, understanding, wisdom, and counsel to help you always desire true goods with right intentions in the proper circumstances.
